Sparkling

Grandial Sparkling, France

A delightful affordable sparkling that is fresh, lively, and dry.

Whites

Casal Garcia Vihno Verde, Portugal

From the Northern Coast of Portugal this slightly sparkling wine is vibrant, full of life, great as an accompaniment for lunch or as an aperitif.

Santa Julia Torrontes, Argentina **Organic**

An aromatic wine with hints of honey and lavender followed by peach and apricot flavors.

Tariquet Classic (Ugni Blanc, Colombard), France

Its bouquet has floral and citrus aromas with touches of tropical fruit. Light and well-balanced this superb dry white is a great thirst quencher.

Tariquet Sauvignon Blanc

A distinctive bouquet with fine intense floral notes, some minerality, and the underlying suggestion of ripe grapes. Fresh and refined with an attractive intensity.

L'Orval Chardonnay, France

A soft gold-colored wine in which honey flavors give way to pineapple, pear and vanilla.

Rosé

La Vieille Ferme Rosé, France

Don't be fooled, this rosé is dry with a floral nose with anise seed and brown sugar. A rich palate balanced with a touch of toffee.

Reds

L'Orval Pinot Noir, France

This wine has a bright ruby color with some nice depth and a bit of structure too. There are some nice berry notes that follow through to your palate with nice balance.

Santa Julia Tempranillo, Argentina **Organic**

Complex, with notes of marmalade, mature fruits, dried mushrooms and spices, vanilla, coffee and roasted almonds. Sweet entry, medium bodied with a great long finish.

La Corte Salice Salentino, Italy

From Apulia, the heel of the boot of Italy, the wine is a dark brick red in color. The nose presents aromas of figs and earth and with a complex palate of both savory and fruit flavors.

McManis Cabernet Sauvignon, USA

Coupled with a deep ruby-purple color, the aroma is layered with hints of blueberries and oak. With lots of dark berry fruit, the palate has a great richness and density.
